Berlin urgently needs a museum for digital art. The Berlin based artist Manuel Rossner lends the city a helping hand, of course with the wink of an eye.

Manuel Rossner thought he would just use the free property between Neue Nationalgalerie (New National Gallery) and Philharmonie in Berlin until 2026, when the Museum of 20th Century by Herzog & de Meuron is planned to open.

New Float is a digital exhibition space with its main focus on presenting and discussing current developments linked to NFTs and digital art. The aim is to create experiences by giving digital art a native and immersive spatial context.

I WROTE THIS SCRIPT

An artwork created by Artificial Intelligence and Manuel Rossner


In the first exhibition he curated in his digital exhibition project Float Gallery in 2012, Manuel Rossner showed the artwork "Video Paint 1.0" by Jeremy Bailey (2004). In the video, Bailey explains the advantages of a painting software he created. Clean hands, savings on materials, and automatically added words like "war" and "love" for meaning are among the advantages.

The presentation starts with the words "I wrote this program.." expressing his excitement about revolutionizing how art is created.

19 years later, artist Manuel Rossner chatted with an artificial intelligence to create the work "I wrote this script". However, it is not he who makes this statement. The full sentence is "I, ChatGPT, a language model developed by OpenAI, wrote the script for the organic form in Unity that you requested earlier."
